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CONTACT YOUR ACADEMIC ADVISOR

As a graduate student, your assigned academic advisor handles all of your enrollment and degree planning. Your advisor is listed on your admission letter. Please stay in touch with your advisor and keep them informed of your educational and professional goals and plans.

If you need help finding your advisor, please contact your graduate admission counselor. Enrollment opens in April for Fall and Summer terms and in November for Spring terms.

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FINANCIAL INFORMATION

File the FAFSA

Graduate financial aid works a little different than undergraduate financial aid, but it still begins with filing the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid—**FAFSA.ED.GOV**). Once you have completed your FAFSA, contact Student Financial Services at 405.208.5211.

STUDENT HEALTH INSURANCE REQUIREMENT

OCU requires that all students maintain health insurance coverage as a condition of enrollment. The insurance fee for the OCU SHIP (Student Health Insurance Plan) is automatically billed to your student account each semester.

If you already have health insurance coverage that meets the university's requirements, there is a SHIP waiver available, which will allow you to waive the university's SHIP and maintain your current insurance coverage.

Fully online students do not need to complete the health insurance waiver.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENT

Oklahoma law requires all students—including grad students—to be vaccinated:

- Hepatitis B
- MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)

Physician Assistant, Nursing, and on-campus students require proof of additional vaccination.

The Campus Health Clinic requires an immunization record on file before August 1.

SUBMIT FINAL DOCUMENTS

Please check with your graduate admission counselor to determine if you need to submit any final, official documents following your admission. OCU requires all students to have final, official transcripts from each institution attended. These transcripts are also required to be on file with the university by the Department of Education before you can receive any federal financial aid.



STUDENT ID

The StarCard is the official ID card of OCU. Students will receive an email closer to the beginning of the semester to upload a picture of their choice for their student ID or a photo can be taken at the Student Accounts office. There is a \$25 student ID fee upon pickup.

Music Students

There is also a mandatory Academic Orientation before classes begin.

Doctoral Nursing Students

All students in DNP and PhD nursing programs are required to attend orientation. Doctoral students also attend three-day intensives prior to each semester. Check with Stacey Warden (**sjwarden@okcu.edu**) or your advisor for more detailed information.

A. Campus Parking

OCU annual parking permits are good from August-July of each year. Parking permits are required of any student, staff, or faculty wishing to park on campus. The permits are available for purchase at the Student Accounts Office beginning in August. okcu.edu/current/financial-aid-office/parking-permit.
