

2	Course	These links and menus take you to various

		to see all the possible tool options your

		homepage (#4 in the chart on the first page).

4	Content	The tool within D2L you will use the most is	
	Browser	probably Content (where professors can share	
		and organize documents, links, and other	
		things for you to access). You can access those	
		things here, OR by clicking on the "Content"	
		link in the Course Menu (#2).	
5	News	Instructors use the News area in a variety of	
		ways – some use to post a single welcome	
		message; others use it to give you timely	
		reminders about the course on a regular basis.	
		(Hints: click the "x" that follows each news	
		item to dismiss it from your view and turn on	
		NOTIFICATIONS – see #3 on the previous page –	
		to get new news items sent to you via email or	
		text.)	
		Keep scrolling down to find an updates widget	
		and a course calendar!

#### • When can I get into D2L?

You can log into D2L as soon as your account is added into the system (usually mid-July for new Fall students). Within D2L, specific courses typically open on the first day of class, unless your professor chooses to open them early.

### Can I get notifications when my professors add things to a course?

Yes! You can turn on Notifications by selecting "Notifications" from the "identity menu" in the upper right hand corner of D2L – see #3 on the previous page
