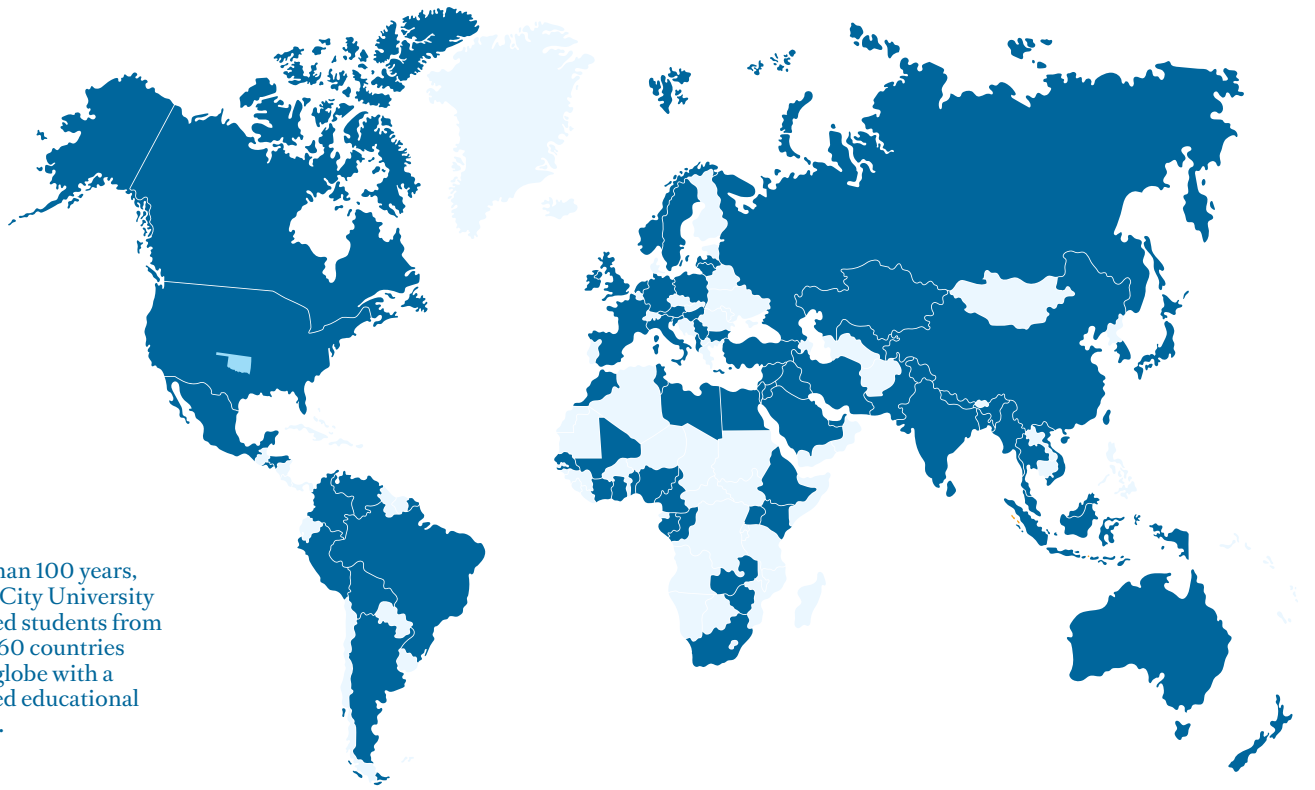

Application Requirements

Complete and submit the following:

- The undergraduate and graduate online application form can be found at okcu.edu/international.
- Copy of passport ID page.
- Original or certified copies of all academic records with a certified English translation.
- Financial statement of support.
- TOEFL, IELTS or intent to study at an ELS Language Center.
- Personal statement/essay. An additional writing sample may be required for some graduate applicants.
- Additional documents required for some majors.



Scholarships

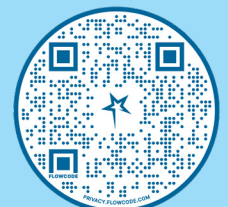
