Accomplishment statements describe your achievements in the experience section of your resume.

APR (Action + Problem/Project + Result)

Think of a project you completed or problem you solved during a job or volunteer experience. Choose an action verb that describes your approach. Then describe the results you achieved, quantifying results when possible.

e.g. Coordinated + three fundraising events for local shelters + which raised more than \$8,000 (20% over goal) and greatly improved community awareness.
