INVESTMENT AND REQUIREMENTS

Application REQUIREMENTS

- A.) The international student online application at okcu.edu/apply.
- B.) Copy of passport ID page.
- C.) Original or certified copies of all academic records with a certified English translation.
- D.) Financial statement of support.
- E.) TOEFL, IELTS or intent to study at a university-approved English language center.
- F.) Non-refundable application fee of \$60.
- G.) Personal statement/essay. An additional writing sample may be required for some graduate applicants.

Note: Additional documents may be required for some majors. More details available at okcu.edu/admissions/international/howtoapply.

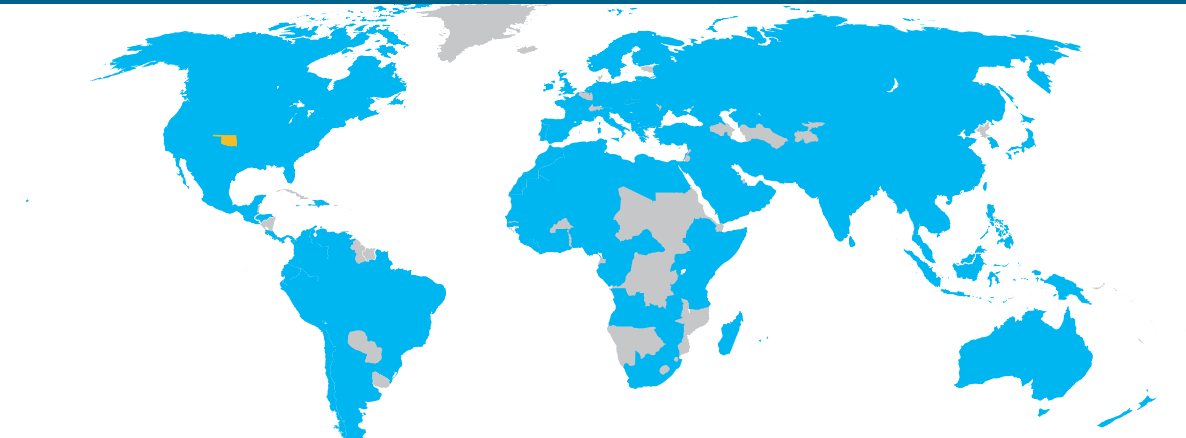

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS

- A.) TOEFL 79 iBT or (some programs have higher requirements) or
- B.) IELTS 6.5 (no subband below 6.0)
- C.) Completion of ELS Language Center EAP Level 112 or another university-approved English Language-Learning Institute.
- D.) Official score reports are required. The OKCU institutional school code is **6543**.
